

SSWGC Slow Play Policy

The Target time for Ladies Day play is 4 1/4 hours or an average of 14 minutes per hole. While slow play may be attributed to a single player, each member of a group finishing the last hole 15 minutes or more behind the group in front MAY be assessed a BAD TIME and therefore will result in an email warning.

Two BAD TIMES in a season by a player or players during the season, a **General Penalty** will be assessed on the final score of play that day.

Three BAD TIMES in a season will result in a **General Penalty** on final score of play that day plus the player or players will be moved to the last tee time for 2 months.

Four BAD TIMES in a season the player or players membership in the SSWG may not be considered the following year.

Who the Penalty Applies To

It is the player's responsibility to know their Group's Position in the field of play. Failure to play within these Pace of Play guidelines above may result in a **General Penalty** to the final score of that play day to All Player's in the Group.

It may be decided to only assess the **General Penalty** to an individual player based on the policy above.

Exceptions

No BAD TIME will be assigned when a group finishes within the 4 1/4 hour timeframe. Extension of the 15 minute final hole limit will be considered if prior group has fewer than four golfers.

There also may be multiple exceptions considered when determining possible penalties.

Notifications

Players will be notified by email when a BAD TIME has been assessed and subsequent infractions thereafter.
